Language courses in German, English, Spanish, French, Japan, Chinese and others – via FSZB: (depending on the language and teaching units, language courses are charged 80€ for 3 ECTS or 160€ for 6 ECTS)

All courses will be worth 3 to 6 credits according to European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). 3 credits are equivalent to a student workload of 2-3 teaching units à 45 minutes plus proportionate additional self-learning per week. 6 credits are equivalent to a student workload of 4-6 teaching units à 45 minutes plus proportionate additional self-learning per week.

There will be similar courses every summer semester, however minor changes are still possible. In order to get the latest course list, please contact us directly.

In addition, exchange students are able to take curricular courses taught in German language. Students should have a minimum level of B2 European Reference Framework to participate. For the current course list of curricular courses taught in German, please contact us.

Proof of Proficiency in English for International Exchange Students

International exchange students intending to take classes/modules taught in English will need to provide evidence that they have sufficient competence in English as part of their application. Sufficient proficiency in English can be proven by supplying internationally accepted test scores, certificates, or other evidence of adequate language competence.

Students will meet the English language proficiency requirement by providing one (1) of the following English language test scores, certificates or statements of confirmation on language level:

1. IELTS (International English Language Test Service) – minimum score 5.5
2. TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) – minimum score
 - Paper-based: 530
 - Computer-based: 197
 - Internet-based (iBT): 71
3. University of Cambridge – one (1) of these certificates
 - First Certificate in English – at least grade B, or
 - Certificate in Advanced English – at least grade C, or
 - Certificate of Proficiency in English – at least grade C
4. UNiCert level II
5. Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB) – minimum score 85
6. **B2** competence level certificate/confirmation from a recognized university language center or a language instructor from your home institution based on the **Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)**
7. Evidence that:
 - Your native (first) language is English
 - You completed your secondary school education with English as the language of instruction
 - You have spent at least one year studying or working in an English-speaking country within the last three years.
8. TOEIC Listening and Reading 785 = B2
